In addition, the association is compiling a brief bank covering legal issues of concern to towns and townships throughout the country.

Seminars presented at this year's annual meeting in September were credited for eight hours of continuing legal education credit with the Ohio Bar College. Among the topics discussed were recent U.S.

Supreme Court decisions affecting zoning and land use planning, USEPA regulations regarding underground oil and gas storage tanks, time and energy management, waste water treatment regulations, and hazardous materials and Superfund requirements. In addition, several media workshops were offered to assist local government attorneys in more effectively representing their client's position before the media.
