AKRON LAW FIRMS MEET THE CHALLENGE

The official results of the Corporate Challenge are available at the Akron Bar Association office. The results contain the times of all the teams in Division III, so we have an idea of what times we have to beat next year. Speaking of next year, there is also a sign-up sheet at the end of the results. There will be an organizational meeting on January 8, 1993, at noon, probably at Napoli's. Please come with ideas and enthusiasm.

While the lawyers on the Akron Bar Association team gave a respectable showing in Division III of the Corporate Challenge, the lawyers in Division II dominated the events. Brouse and McDowell came in first out of thirty two teams with 3262 points. Buckingham, Doolittle & Burroughs came in a very close second with 3210 points. Roetzel & Andress came in 17th place with 2040 points. Great job!

In the mixed 100 yard medley relay, Brouse took first, Buckingham took second and Roetzel took ninth out of twenty teams. In the men's 100 yard medley swim, Buckingham took second and Roetzel took tenth out of twenty teams. In the women's 100 yard medley, Brouse came in first out of seven teams, with a time of 1:10.8 (The ABA team's time was 1:10.15).

In the men's 200 yard relay, Buckingham came in second and Brouse came in third out of nineteen teams. In the Women's 200 yard relay, Brouse swam in first (2:12.88), Buckingham swam in fourth (2:39.69), and Roetzel swam in seventh (2:44.49) out of seventeen teams. (The ABA time was 2:12.95). In the mixed crescendo relay swimming, Buckingham came in first (2:20.04), Brouse came in fifth (2:39.30), and Roetzel came in ninth (2:51.64) out of 23 teams. (The ABA's time was 2:30.08) in the time prediction, Brouse came in fourth, Roetzel came in eleventh, and Buckingham came in 23rd.

Out on the innerbelt, in the mixed 5K, Robert Cindiff, Tom Crookes and Katherine Neumann helped Brouse take fourth, while Roetzel took ninth. In the Men's 5K, Brouse had three of the top

four finishers: Scot Harvey (16:7.65), David Hunter (17:6.65), and Stanley Everett (17:46). Their times, combined with Paul Rose's fast finish put Brouse in an easy first. Buckingham came in a strong second. In the Women's 5K, Buckingham took third.

In the one mile time prediction walk/jog, Buckingham took fifth. Roetzel took sixth and Brouse took 20th place. In the 10K relay, Brouse ran in first (42:18.24) and Buckingham took seventh (45:4.54). (The ABA team ran the 10K in 45:3.77.)

In the mixed crescendo bicycling time prediction, the Buckingham team (David Nolin, Frank Quirk, Greg Richardson and Michael Sweeney) took third and Brouse took tenth.

On Sunday, Buckingham came in second and Brouse came in twelfth in the mixed 4 x 100 relay. In the men's 4 x 100 relay, Brouse came in ninth (51.33), Roetzel came in 16th (54.11) and Buckingham came in 22nd (56:84). (The ABA team's time was 51.05.) Roetzel came in sixth in the women's 4 x 100 relay. In the 4 x 400, Brouse finished first (4:32.33), with Roetzel coming in at 16th (5:21.41) and Buckingham at 19th (5:29.85). The ABA team's time was 5:19.76.)

In the tug of war, Buckingham pulled a seventh place, Brouse followed in twelfth, and Roetzel in 22nd out of 29 teams.

Roetzel beat both firms in the t-shirt competition and came in second

overall; Brouse came in third. Roetzel also beat the other firms in the cheerleading competition, coming in second place. Brouse and McDowell won the banner competition.

Scanlon & Gearing represented the attorneys in Division I. Scanlon & Gearing won a gold medal in the mixed 10K, coming in first out of fifteen teams. The team grabbed a bronze medal in the men's 5K. The firm came in eighth out of 24 teams in the one-mile time prediction walk/jog. The team's predicted time was 153:55 and the team's actual time was 156:59.31. In the bicycling time prediction, Scanlon & Gearing came in fourth out of 22 teams.

Congratulations to all the attorneys who participated in the Corporate Challenge on any of the teams.
