Michael DelMedico and Patrick Hart have recently been named co-managing partners of Scanlon & Gearing Co., L.P.A.

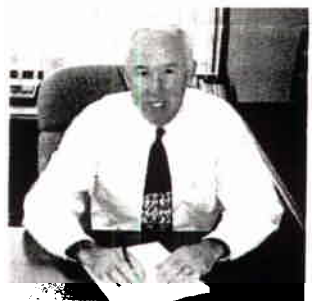
Throughout the years, the firm has built a unique reputation of having the resources, know-how, and expertise to handle the most complex cases.
